## In Other Words ...

Roughly two weeks before the move... and everyone keeps asking, "Are you ready, are you all packed?" My stock answer is, "Sure, why not?" Are we ever really ready to move?

Now mind you, I am saying this as an itinerate United Methodist pastor who has made 8 moves in twenty years. We have gotten good at it. We have bought our own set of furniture dollies (large and small), appliance hand truck, and maintain a supply of packing boxes from one move to the next. But none of that actually gets the boxes packed. None of that fills out the change of address forms. None of that finds the new doctor, dentist, veterinarian, pharmacy, dry cleaner, etc.

It is a process.

Along with that process is the process of saying goodbye to the congregation you have served (the process you all are facing with Pastor Megan), and preparing the task of learning all the new names and faces in the new congregation. So please bear with us and know that it will take a little bit of time. I certainly get that it has been a while since you all have been through this process; after all, Pastor Megan came to you as a known entity.

Thankfully, we do have a process for all of this (after all Methodists have a method for everything!). In West Ohio, the program is called Starting Well. Like many other events and programs of the church, it has been a while since we have used it due to the interruption of all things during COVID-19. But this year, the Annual Conference is re-instituting the process for the first time since 2019.

Over the course of the next several weeks, we will begin the exercises, the discussions, and the process the Starting Well program suggests. But here is the thing I want to make sure we all understand: the program tends to focus upon the relationship of starting our relationships well; the relationship between the congregation and the newly arrived pastor.

HOWEVER . . . Ministry does not stop to allow that process to take place. So, there is a thought that the real nature of the program should be Continuing Well. It is because there are vital ministries that Trinity UMC of Lima provides to the community that cannot wait for us all to meet. They need to continue to serve those people that need those services most. Things like Sunday Morning Breakfast, the program being launched to provide a Freedom School-type experience for kids in Lima, the work of the Peace and Reconciliation Center. I am looking forward to helping and participating in all of these (and others that I might have missed) despite the need to learn new things and meet new people along the way.
