Dear Siblings in Christ:

My only child is getting ready to graduate from high school (67 days from writing this- not that I'm counting). It has already been an emotional season getting to see him grow into himself while at the same time feeling the weight of so many "lasts." As difficult as it is to think about all of these lasts, I've also been able to experience joy with him as he looks forward with hope. As I reflect on this stage in life for both of us, I can't help but think of the Easter story of resurrection. Christianity, religion, even our own personal faith journeys tend to have a cyclical life pattern. We go through seasons of new awakening, seasons of stagnation, and seasons where we try to grasp on to the traditions, the feelings, the experiences of the past. The promise of the Gospel, no matter what season we find ourselves in is that there is always hope in the new life we have in Christ. The focus is on the "new"... on the resurrection, on looking forward.

This Lenten season we have spent a lot of time seeking a deeper faith through our questions. We have explored some of the encounters that Jesus had with people from all walks of life- the powerful and the powerless, men and women, the faithful and the uncertain, the blind, hungry and thirsty. We saw how in each encounter Jesus met the person or persons where they were and used their physical need to illustrate a spiritual truth. He gave each person hope and offered them a chance to live a new life embracing the spiritual gift that Christ offers.

As I look ahead at my son's future- I am moved to remember that the graduation ceremony is called "commencement" for a reason. It is a new beginning, a new life. Not one that is uninfluenced by the experiences, upbringing, friends, family and education that has led him to this point, but a new beginning that is shaped by where he has come from and embraces the new with a mindset for growth. My prayer for him is to continue to ask questions, to grow, to embrace the new while cherishing where he has been. My prayer is for him to experience faith and a living hope as he continues to grow in faith and love. And really, that isn't such a bad prayer for all of us... This Easter season may we look forward with "A Living Hope" trusting in the new life we have in Christ to transform our hearts to love as Christ loves us.


