That helped me a lot even before I came to Lima. My inlaws and the congregation were so kind, and treated me with respect. I'll never forget the kindness of the people Trinity has been my church since 1951." 

from Pastor Jim....

My passport has nine stamps in it; Nicaragua, Nicaragua, Nicaragua, Nicaragua, Nicaragua, Nicaragua, Nicaragua, Nicaragua, and Nicaragua. I took a transcultural trip in 2005 and I loved the product so much, I bought the company (or in this case the ministry). After a chance encounter with Cheryl Avery, Executive Director of Project Chacocente, we took a tour of her ministry field; the Managua city dump. Over 200 families made their home inside

the dump. Another 2000 people would come and go into the dump on a daily basis to 'work' the dump (which is a polite way to say scavenge). The dump had its own sense of economy. People would scavenge for anything of value. Others would buy those things; glass, rubber, metal. Package them up and transport them back out of the dump to sell at recycling centers for a profit. Three months later, I was President of the US Board of Directors that helped raised the money to fund Project Chacocente.

Project Chacocente is a community of ten families relocated from the dump to a property outside of Masaya, Nicaragua. Assuming the families sent their kids to school. Took classes in finances, community building, hygiene, and to learn a trade. Shared the work in and around the community and on the community farm land. Do all this for five years... Then they were promised clear title to the land and home where they lived. Over time, we built our own school. Invited people in the surrounding community beyond Chacocent to send their kids to our school as well. We saw the Spanish Royal family (humiliated by the collection of videos of the dump conditions) purchase the dump and rehabilitate it to proper standards. After a water crisis, we received funding for our own well. We saw graduates of our school head off to colleges and universities. There are lots of stories to tell!

After the 2019 uprisings in Nicaragua and the subsequent governmental crack down, many US ministries were seized and the property confiscated. Project Chacocente was seized in 2021. The residents were allowed to keep their land, but we lost the school. Most of the families that were left, did make their income by working in the school in one capacity or another. It is hard to say if the government allowed them to keep working in those capacities.

But hear this – the time spent in Nicaragua was not in vain. Everything we built, every relationship made, every student we connected with; we did so with prayer. We did so invoking God's good blessings. We did so as a witness in the moment to the Kingdom of God and in the ongoing nature of God's Kingdom, which reigns regardless of the political climate.
