Jim also serves as part of the Conference Missional Church Development Team (which awarded Trinity with a Go Grant to help launch the Peace and Reconciliation Center this past year).

Jami also serves the Annual Conference in ministry as a lay person. All-In Community is a mission initiative of the West Ohio Annual Conference that works across the criminal Justice continuum – victims, the incarcerated, returning and restored citizens after incarceration as well as all of their families. Jami works as the Training and Ministries Coordinator for All In Community and is often out visiting other congregations making presentations on Sunday mornings.

Both Jim and Jami are very committed to empowering laity to answer their call to ministry; building community beyond the walls of the church. They are very excited to join the vision already being followed at Trinity UMC in widening the community circle. The best way to grow the church is to live out the love of Jesus by serving, accepting, and loving people where they are and offering hope for a better tomorrow.
