When Evan was 18 months old, I began looking for a daycare. When talking to the daycare staff where he ended up, the director shared some important ways they like to partner with parents. She shared how it was important that we talk to, read and engage with our young children even before they can talk. To me that seemed obvious, but she shared that some parents didn't realize that adults talking is crucial to their toddlers' language development. Each time I read my son a story afterwards, I was mindful of the ways these stories would influence his life. As his story listening slowly turned to his memorizing "what happened next" which turned into his own sounding out words which eventually turned into his devouring story after story, I couldn't help but recognize how the act of storytelling, whether from real life, myth or some exaggerated retold tale, has shaped and will continue to shape who he is and how he understands and responds to the world around him.

Christian literature is filled with stories of God's relationship with humanity. Stories about a messed up family trying to figure out how to live with one another and what to do with the hurt that they did to one another. Stories about a young nation trying to find its place in the world. Stories about suffering and comfort, betrayal and love, anger and hope. Stories about a man who taught new ways of understanding God by telling stories. Stories about a man who lived and lived again, and in doing so, changed the way we read all the stories that came before and shaped the stories that have been told since.

Our stories, those we hear, those we read, those we tell, and those that we experience matter. Our faith is formed, shaped and communicated through the art of storytelling. How our stories interact with God's story informs how we live our faith on a daily basis. This month we will explore the stories of our faith and the stories of those in our community and how they integrate with God's story. Join us as we worship, study and celebrate together.
